AGREEMENT FOR TEENS

I PROMISE I WILL OBEY ALL RULES OF THE ROAD

- Always wear a seat belt and make my passengers buckle up
- Obey all traffic lights, stop signs, other street signs, and road markings
- Stay within the speed limit, and drive safely
- Never use the car to race or to try to impress
- Never give rides to hitchhikers

I PROMISE I WILL STAY FOCUSED ON DRIVING

- Never text or email while driving (writing, reading, or sending messages)
- Turn cell phone off, keep out of reach, or download an app that prevents phone use
- Drive with both hands on the wheel
- Never use headphones or earbuds to listen to music while driving
- Drive only when I am alert and in emotional control
- As a passenger, offer to help so my driver does not drive distracted

I PROMISE I WILL FOLLOW LAWS ABOUT DRUGS AND ALCOHOL

- Drive only when I am alcohol and drug free
- Never allow any alcohol or illegal drugs in the car
- Be a passenger only with drivers who are alcohol and drug free
- Call my parents for a ride home if I am impaired in any way, or if my driver is impaired
